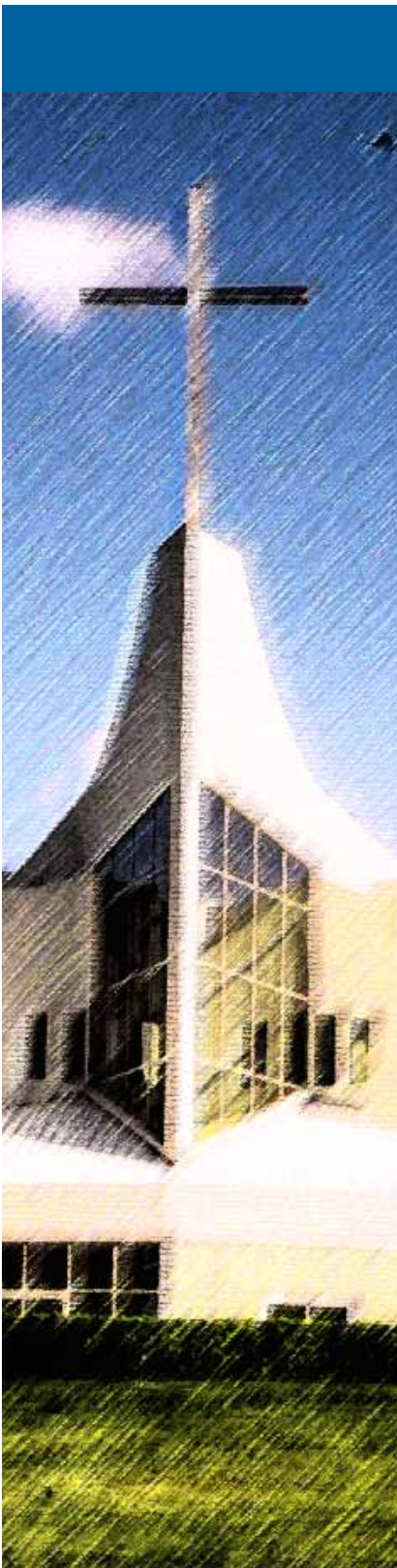
Volunteers are needed to transport larger items on March 21<sup>st</sup>. If you have a large vehicle and a servant's heart, please contact Barbara Fahey.
